Chip Timing

The Cote Dame Marie will be timed using Chip Timing technology. The chip will be attached to your bib. Please do not fold or bend the chip. There is no need to return the chip after the race.

Course

All races will start and finish at the same locations. The race start is located behind the ball field. The finish line is at the base of the ski hill behind the lodge building. Both the start and finish areas are only a short ski/walk from warming areas. The course will be a loop trail. The 13k races will complete one lap of the course and the 26k race will complete one lap and then continue up the ski hill and connect back to the loop and complete a second lap. The Junior and Citizen race course will follow the Michigan Cup course for the first 3K and then split to the right for 3K before rejoining the main course. All intersections will be marked. The Citizen and Junior course will be set with a classic track the entire length.

Kilometer Markers

Kilometers markers are placed along the race course in ascending order.

Food and First Aid Stations

There will be two aide stations located on the course – one at 10k (22k on second lap) and the second at the finish line area.

Results

Results will be posted periodically at the Hanson Hills Lodge. Final results will be posted at Awards Banquet located at RAMADA INN, Grayling.

Protests

Protests should be submitted to the race Director, Justin Andre, by 12:30 PM.

Awards

Age group and Overall Division awards will be presented in all divisions at the Awards Banquet (Ramada Inn, Grayling)
